Depending on the vehicle version and equipment, modifications may be necessary during installation with respect to these "Installation Documentation".

However, the stipulations in this "installation documentation", the "operating instructions" and "installation instructions" for the *Thermo Top C* must always be observed.

The corresponding rules of technology and any information from the vehicle manufacturer should be observed during the installation work.

General Instructions

Installation should be carried out according to the general, standard rules of technology. Unless specified otherwise, fasten hoses, lines and wiring harnesses to original vehicle lines and wiring harnesses using cable ties. Insulate loose wire ends and tie back. 



Mounting silencer






Exhaust Gas




